How to Tell if Your GEM is Completely Charged

To ensure that your GEM is 100% charged you can follow these easy steps.

1. First, start by plugging the car in and look at the display. You should see a charger cord icon and the battery icon of the display illuminated. (See Figure 1)

2. When the charging cycle is complete after 8 to 14 hours (depending on battery pack of 6-12volt or 9-8volt) the battery icon will go out and all you should see still illuminated is the charger cord icon of the display. (See Figure 2)

3. You can also determine 100% charge by looking at the charger located under the hood. Kneel down beside the driver's front wheel. Look over the tire toward the center of the vehicle. Locate the yellow and black charger unit. When left plugged in to charge a solid green light should appear on the charger, indicating 100% charge cycle. (See figure 3)
